Thanksgiving, we are looking for donations of food staples to put

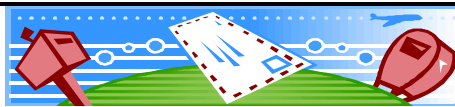
together the baskets given out each Thanksgiving.

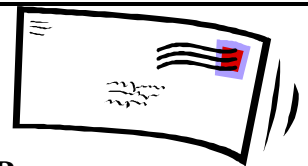
